*After being at Oakdale, students share what is impacting them:*

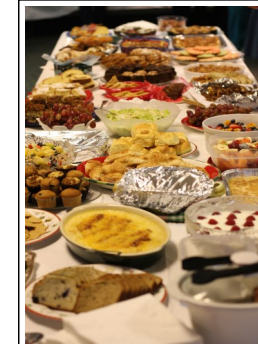

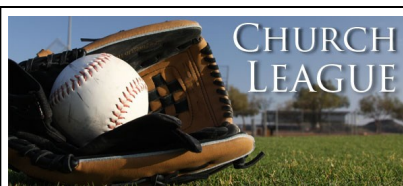
