Here are a few items that are good to know about our worship gatherings:

The **WORSHIP GUIDE** will lead you through the worship services. We try to use elements of liturgy from a variety of ages and Christian traditions to help people of all ages, stages and tastes actively participate in worship.

NURSERY for children up to 2 years is available in *Building B Pre-school Wing* (Main Floor) for the entire morning every Sunday.

CHILDREN'S WORSHIP JR. (CWJR - ages 2 & 3) is available in *Building B Pre-school Wing* (Main Floor) for the entire morning every Sunday.

SUMMER CHILDREN'S WORSHIP for children age 4 through grade one meets in Room A104 downstairs. After the Children's Time, children will return to their families. The children can then leave the Sanctuary following the offering where they will be escorted by CW Staff. Following 8:30 worship, parents of children ages 4 through Kindergarten must pick up their children from Room A104.

Children in grade 1 will be taken to their Sunday School classroom. Following 10:50 worship, parents must pick up their children from Room A104.

WHEELCHAIR SEATING is available in the center aisle, or an usher will be glad to remove a sanctuary chair for your convenience.

THE WELCOME CENTER in the foyer is staffed before and after each service with friendly, helpful people who provide directions, information, and answers.

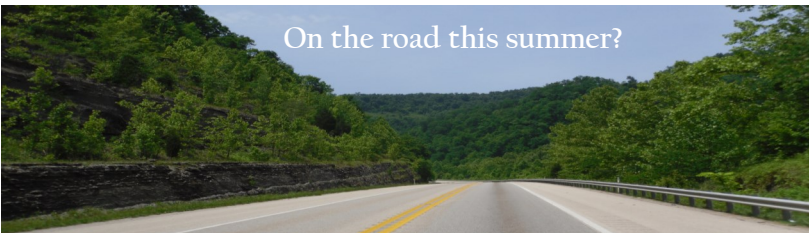
