

# WELCOME

The WFMC family is so glad you've joined us for worship! Here are some details that you may find helpful.

**THE COMMUNICATION CARD** is key to allowing us to welcome you fully. Please fill it out and, after worship, drop it by the Welcome Center where you'll find lots of information and a nice gift for every first-time visitor.

**THE WORSHIP GUIDE** in this folder will lead you through our service. We try to use elements, liturgy, and sacraments from a variety of Christian traditions to help lead people of all ages, stages, and tastes into the presence of God. Worship is participatory, so please join in prayer, word, giving, and song.
