We're so glad you've joined us for Worship today! Here are some details that you may find helpful in your first visit here.

THE COMMUNICATION CARD is key in allowing us to welcome you fully. Please fill it out and, after worship, drop it by the Welcome Center where you'll find lots of information and a nice gift for every first-time visitor. You won't be accosted, we promise.

THE WORSHIP GUIDE in this folder will lead you through our service order. We try to use elements of liturgy from a variety of Christian traditions to help lead people of all ages, stages, and tastes into the presence of God. Worship is participatory, so please join in prayer, word, giving, and song.

NURSERY CARE for children up to 2 years is available for the entire morning in the Preschool Complex, Building B.

CHILDREN'S WORSHIP JR.—CWJR (ages 2 and 3) is available all year for the entire morning worship service in the Preschool Complex, Building B.

SUMMER CHILDREN'S WORSHIP—SCW for children age 4 through grade 1 meets in Room A104 downstairs. After the Children's Time, children return to their families, then leave the Sanctuary during the doxology where they will be escorted by CW Staff. Following 8:30 worship, parents of children ages 4 through Kindergarten must pick up their children from Room A104. Children in grade 1 will be taken to their Sunday School classroom. Following 10:50 worship, parents must pick up their children from Room A104. (Regular CW for children through grade 3 begins again in September.)

HEARING ASSISTANCE DEVICES are available in the foyer.

WHEELCHAIR SEATING is readily available in the center aisle or an usher will be glad to remove a sanctuary chair for your convenience.

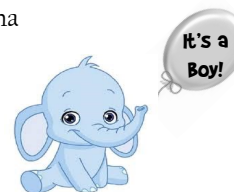

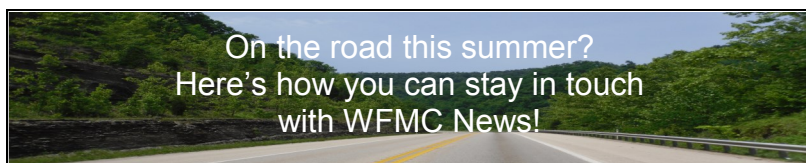
