HEARING ASSISTANCE DEVICES are available in the foyer.

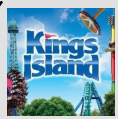
WHEELCHAIR SEATING is available in the center aisle, or an usher will be glad to remove a sanctuary chair for your convenience.

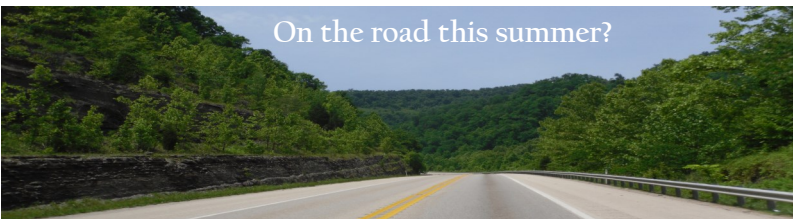
