

# WELCOME

The WFCM family is so glad you've joined us for worship! Here are some details that you may find helpful.

**THE COMMUNICATION CARD** is key to allowing us to welcome you fully. Please fill it out and, after worship, drop it by the Welcome Center where you'll find lots of information and a nice gift for every first-time visitor.

**THE WORSHIP GUIDE** in this folder will lead you through our service. We try to use elements, liturgy, and sacraments from a variety of Christian traditions to help lead people of all ages, stages, and tastes into the presence of God. Worship is participatory, so please join in prayer, word, giving, and song.

**NURSERY** for children up to 2 years is available for the entire morning in the Pre-school Complex, Building B.

**CHILDREN'S WORSHIP JR.** (CWJR, age 2 and 3) is available all year for the entire morning worship service in the Pre-school Complex, Building B.

**CHILDREN'S WORSHIP**, for children age four through grade three, is currently taking a short break to give the CW staff a much needed rest. Summer session for children age 4 through grade 1 begins on July 7. Children's Worship for grades 2 and 3 begins again August 25.
