

# WELCOME

Please help us be hospitable to you by filling out the white COMMUNICATION CARD and dropping it by the WELCOME CENTER in the main foyer.

Here are a few items that are good to know about our worship gatherings:

The **WORSHIP GUIDE** will lead you through the worship services. We try to use elements of liturgy from a variety of ages and Christian traditions to help people of all ages, stages and tastes actively participate in worship.

**NURSERY** for children up to 2 years is available in *Building B Pre-school Wing* (Main Floor) for the entire morning every Sunday.

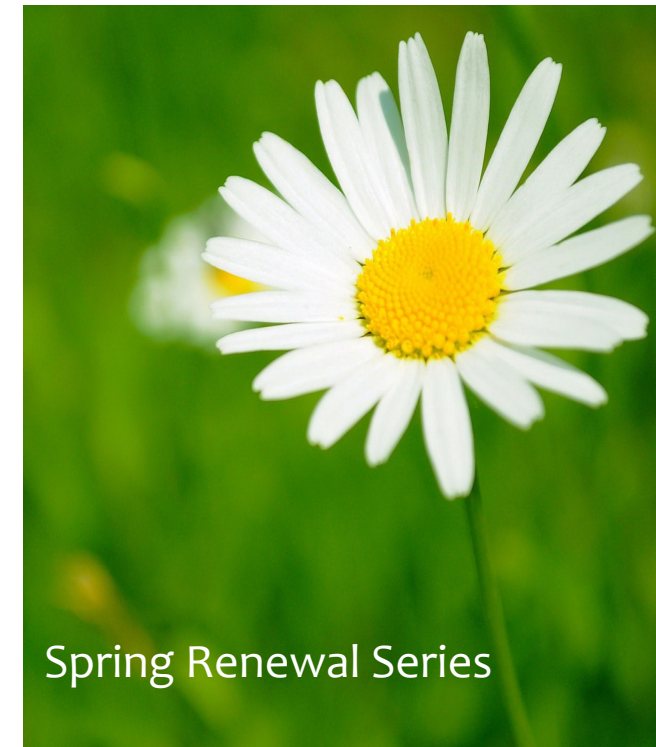

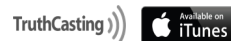
