VBS Set Up/Clean Up Times

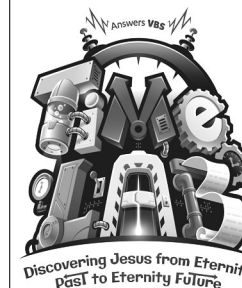
- Tonight after evening worship we will clear several rooms so decorating may begin for VBS.
