

# WELCOME

We're so glad you've joined us for Worship today! Here are some details that you may find helpful in your first visit here.

**THE COMMUNICATION CARD** is key to allowing us to welcome you fully. Please fill it out and, after worship, drop it by the Welcome Center where you'll find lots of information and a nice gift for every first-time visitor.

**THE WORSHIP GUIDE** in this folder will lead you through our service. We try to use elements, liturgy, and sacraments from a variety of Christian traditions to help lead people of all ages, stages, and tastes into the presence of God. Worship is participatory, so please join in prayer, word, giving, and song.

**NURSERY** for children up to 2 years is available for the entire morning in the Pre-school Complex, Building B.

**CHILDREN'S WORSHIP JR.** (CWJR, age 2 and 3) is available all year for the entire morning worship service in the Pre-school Complex, Building B.

**CHILDREN'S WORSHIP (CW)** for children age 4 through grade 3 meets in Rooms A102 and A104 downstairs. After the Children's Time, children return to their families, then leave the Sanctuary during the doxology where they will be escorted by CW Staff. Following 8:30 worship, parents of children ages 4 through Kindergarten must pick up their children from Room A104. Children in grades 1-3 will be taken to their Sunday School classroom. Following 10:50 worship, parents must pick up their children from A102 or A104 downstairs.

**WHEELCHAIR SEATING** is readily available in the center aisle or an usher will be glad to remove a sanctuary chair for your convenience.

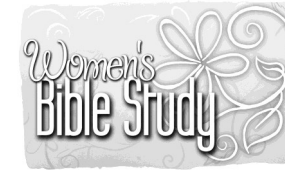
