Children

Nursery - Cares for our youngest worshippers one shift per month <①

Children's Sunday School - Teaches and supports the children's Sunday school ministry, age 2 - grade 5 ①

Children's Worship - A place for our children, age 4 - grade 3, to learn how to "Be still and know that I am God." CW needs storytellers and greeters committed to 3 Sundays (one service), 3-4 times per school year - a small commitment for an eternal investment <①

Children's Worship Junior - Helps children (ages 2 - 3) learn how to worship in semi-structured setting (story, snack, structured play); commitment is for one month on a 3 to 4 month rotation <①

Christian Life Club - Teachers and assistants needed for this Wednesday night children's ministry (during school year) ①

Summer Fun - Teaches or supports the Wednesday night children's ministry during the summer months <①

Vacation Bible School - Leads and assists with VBS each summer ???

Youth



Friendship Ministry - Help our youth build relationships with residents of Royal Manor and Thomson Hood Veterans Center on Wednesday nights from 6:45-8:00pm >①

Fun Fridays - Monthly fun events for youth, typically on Fridays; volunteers supervise, invest relationally in students, drive vans or organize/plan events ???

Open Gym - Provides supervision and encouragement to youth through recreation and sports >①

Trail Life - Assists in this high-adventure, character-building ministry on Monday nights ???

Youth Bible Fellowships - Teaches and supports the youth Sunday school ministry, grades 6-12 ①

Youth Afterglows - A post-Sunday evening service fellowship time for youth, grades 6-12; hosts provide snacks for approximately 20 middle school or high school youth either in their homes or in Building C ???

Youth Prayer Breakfast - Early Morning Prayer time (Tuesdays) for youth, grades 6-12; volunteers help with breakfast preparations, provide breakfast, lead small prayer groups, drive students to school/home following breakfast ①

Bible Quiz Team - Helps our teens study and memorize Scripture, team meets weekly through school year on Wednesdays from 5-6:25pm, with monthly trips to quiz meets (typically in Indiana) ???

WFMY - Helps with the Wednesday night WFMY programming, invests in students through relationship building, teaching, and small group facilitating >①

WFMY Dinner Ministry - Provides a meal for the youth and WFMY Staff during school year ???

WFMY Kitchen Crew - Prepares and Serves youth dinner weekly during the school year >①



Adults

Adult Bible Fellowships / Electives - Teaches or coordinates care and nurture in adult Christian education >①

College/University/Young Adult Ministries - Teaches, assists, and mentors our young adults ①

Financial Counselors - Offer support and instruction for those in need of financial planning advice ???

Homebound Visitation - Provides encouragement 3-4 times per month to a homebound WFMC member ①

Men's Ministry - Leads and supports men's activities, including special and monthly events and small groups ???

Seminary Ministry - Helps with fellowship and events geared toward seminary students <①

Seniors Ministry - Works with active seniors of the church in activities, prayer, study and fellowship <①

Singles Ministry - Leads and supports ministry to singles ???

Family Team - Develops and supports programs encouraging healthy Biblical parenting and families ???

Hospital Visitation - Visits hospitalized WFMC members one day per week >①

Moving Ministry - Helps families move in / out of our community ???

Overseas Fellowship - Encourages and provides fellowship with those who have had cross-cultural experiences ???

Parish Nursing - Nurses available for occasional education, consultation and blood pressure readings <①

Prayer Team - Plans church prayer ministries and events ???

Small Groups - Leads and supports small group ministries ???

Transportation Team - Provides occasional transport of non-driving WFMC members to doctor appointments, etc. <①

Welcome Team - Visits or phones newcomers who have attended worship a second time <①

Welcome Center Hosts - Welcomes new attendees and provides information to all through the foyer Welcome Center ①

Common Threads - Knits/crochets prayer shawls for distribution to the sick and troubled in our community >①

Funeral Dinner - Helps provide a meal at the church following funeral services. Volunteers provide a dish or help serve <①

Home Mission Team - Leads and supports local/regional mission projects ???

Outreach Team - Leads and participates in outreach events <①

Panera Bread - Picks up Panera leftovers (Brannon) on Monday nights and delivers to WFMC on Tuesday mornings <①

Recovery Ministry - Administrates and supports recovery ministries ???

Royal Manor Nursing Home - Assists in leading Saturday services at Royal Manor Nursing Home in Nicholasville >❶

School Outreach Team - Acts as liaison between a county school and the team to report material needs of the resource centers <❶

World Mission Team - Supports world mission effort <❶

Buildings Care Team - Maintains facilities through occasional work days and special projects ❶

Building Hosts Team - Hosts groups that use our facilities ❶

Facility Set-Up - Sets up and tears down rooms for ministry events <❶

Grounds Care Team - Enjoy being outside? Like to get your hands dirty and remove pesky weeds? If so, the Grounds Team would appreciate your assistance ❶

Landscape Equipment Maintenance - Maintains our tractors and mowers ❶

Sanctuary Sweepers - Vacuum the sanctuary once every other month in 4 - month intervals ❶

Van/Bus Maintenance - Maintains/cleans our church vehicles ❶

Van/Bus Ministry - Drivers for vans and bus (CDL required for bus) ???

Communion Stewards - Prepare and clean up communion elements for worship services <❶

Greeters - Greets worshippers entering grounds and buildings ❶

Music Worship Team - Participates in one of the rotating instrumental music teams which lead congregational worship ❶

Parking Attendants - Help with parking cars for services <❶

Pen Ministry - Maintains pens in sanctuary seats - a great area for

children to learn to serve ❶

Sanctuary Choir - Presents vocal music ministry in worship services throughout the school year - singers and administrative support are both needed ❶

Sanctuary Décor - Helps with weekly and seasonal worship service décor and advisory support for general church décor ❶

Sanctuary Resource Care - Helps with clean-up of hymnals/ supplements/cards between worship services <❶

Solo/Small Ensemble Music Opportunities - Provides musical offerings during worship services ???

Special Needs - Ministers one-on-one with a special needs child or adult during morning worship <❶

Ushers - Greet and assist worshippers on Sundays and Wednesdays <❶
