

In-Person Worship/Events Plan.Version 3.0
Updated, November 17, 2020

Regarding In-Person Worship:

In-person worship services began on June 14 and continue with two services, 8:30 and 11:00 each Sunday morning, meeting in the Sanctuary and room B200-201. Seating is first come, first served. No “reservations” necessary.

During the greeting times, please avoid awkwardness by not attempting to shake hands, hug or touch others.

Offerings will be collected at the rear of the sanctuary/room as you exit to avoid passing of plates.

Child care through age 3 is available during all church functions.

Children’s Worship (age 4 - grade 3) is presently available during the 8:30 worship only.

All social distancing protocols will be observed in all church group gatherings, which means:

- Persons / family units should enter, sit, interact, and leave according to current distancing guidelines.
- The use of masks while moving, while less than six feet from others, and while singing is requested.
- All who attend should self-examine for illness and use appropriate caution for the sake of others.

Group and choral singing / rehearsals are on hold.

Please note that these precautions in no way guarantee a “safe” environment; there is always a level of risk in gathering and interacting with other persons.

The 8:30 service will be livestreamed on the WPMC YouTube channel and kept there for ongoing viewing.

Regarding Sunday School/Youth and Adult Bible Fellowships and Wednesday Night Programs:

The SS/YBF/ABF groups / ministries began in-person on July 12 at 9:45a. Most now meet on campus, some with Zoom components, and a couple meeting via Zoom only.

The Wednesday Night groups / ministries began in-person on July 15, with ministries for all ages.

All social distancing protocols will be observed in all church ministry / group gatherings, which means:

- Persons / family units should enter, sit, interact, and leave according to distancing guidelines, using care to choose rooms / areas that accommodate spacing requirements.
- The use of masks while moving, while less than six feet from others, and while singing is requested.
- All who attend should self-examine for illness and use appropriate caution for the sake of others.

Regarding Church Social Events:

We have suspended indoor, *all-church* social events.

Church *group* social events may be held on campus following the distancing protocols, including:

- Persons / family units should enter, sit, interact, and leave according to distancing guidelines, using care to choose rooms / areas that accommodate spacing requirements.
- The use of masks while moving, while less than six feet from others, and while singing is requested.
- We expect all who attend to self-examine for illness and use appropriate caution for the sake of others.

Church events involving food should take special care to avoid unhygienic practices that encourage the spread of germs, corona or otherwise, such as the use of common serving utensils, crowded serving lines, etc.
