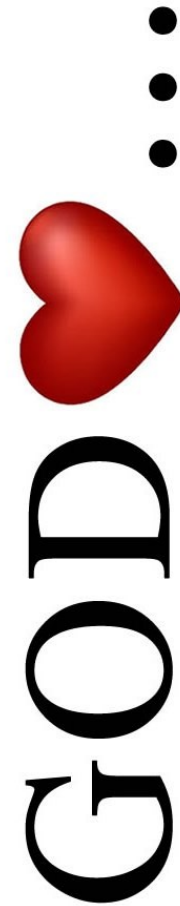

 To the praise of His glory. Amen.


