

SUNDAY NIGHT, JUNE 28 6:00P

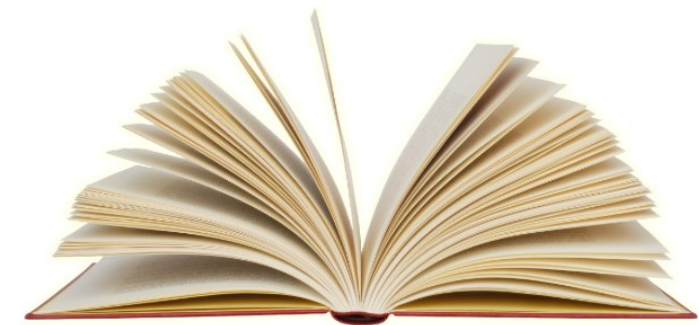

Service for Healing and Wholeness

Tonight at 6:00p

"Come to Me, you weary, and I'll give us rest."

"Pray for and anoint for healing those who are sick."

"Ask, seek and knock, and you will find."

If you've never been part of a healing service before, here's how it works: all those seeking healing fill out a card, stating the need specifically or generally, then come to the altar for prayer as there is room. Confidential needs are kept confidential.

The needs of those who don't mind the congregation knowing their need will be shared (generally) then prayed for and anointed.

We continue like that until all who want prayer have been prayed for, then we'll receive Holy Communion together as a response to God's perfect and healing grace. The entire service lasts, generally, no more than one hour.

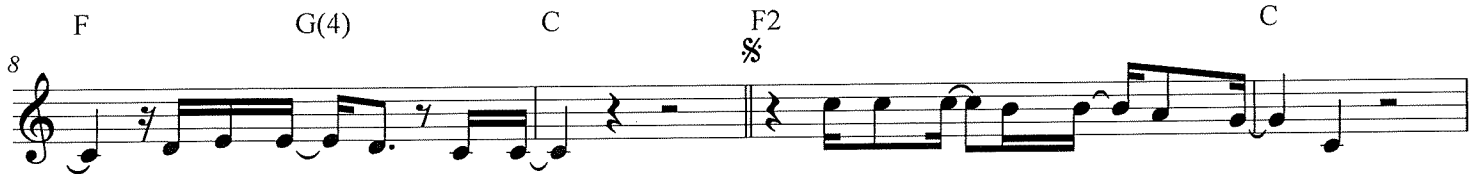
