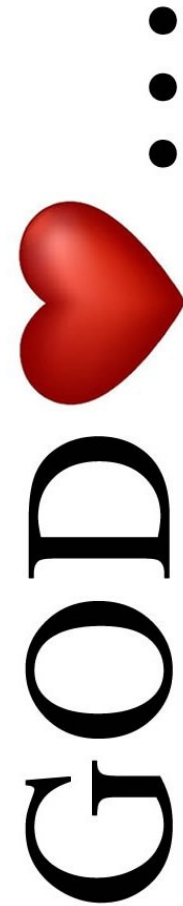

**Independence Day Water Outreach**

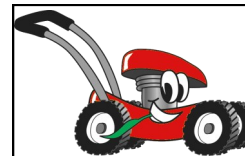
