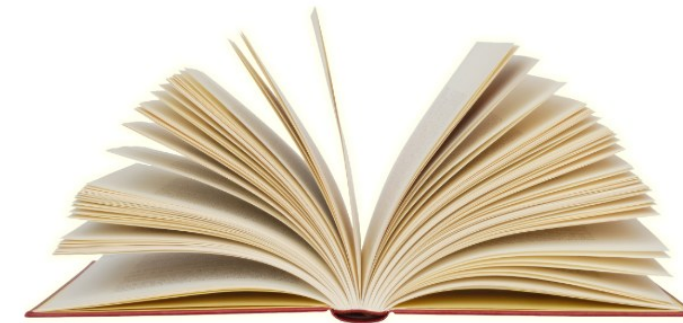
**SPOT** THE IT
