If you seek or have found salvation or sanctification today, please let a member of the pastoral staff know. We're here to help you on your journey.

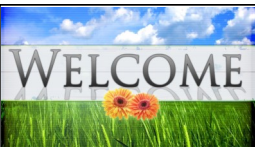
