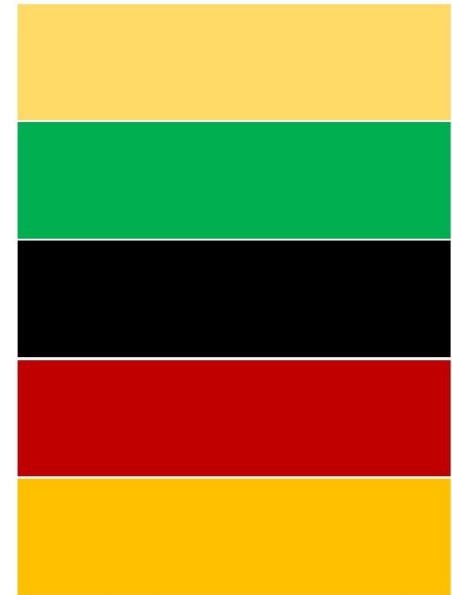

If you seek or have found salvation or sanctification today, please let a member of the pastoral staff know. We're here to help you on your journey.



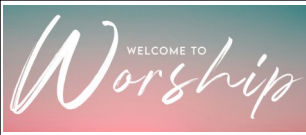

Welcome to worship at WFMC!
Here are some helpful notes if you are new:
THE COMMUNICATION CARD is key to allowing us to welcome you fully. Please fill it out and drop it off at the Welcome Center in the foyer. The attendants there will give you a nice gift, and, though the pastors won't harass you, they will send you a welcoming note.

THE WORSHIP GUIDE in this folder leads through the service. We try to use elements, liturgy, music and sacraments from a variety of Christian traditions to help lead people of all ages, stages, and tastes into God's presence. Worship is participatory, so please join in prayer, word, giving, and song, and respond to the voice of the Holy Spirit however He leads.

NURSERY for children up to 2 years is available all morning in the Pre-school Complex, Building B.

CHILDREN'S WORSHIP JR. (CWJR, age 2 and 3) is available all year for both morning worship services in the Pre-school Complex, Building B.

CHILDREN'S WORSHIP (CW, age 4 through grade 3) After the Children's Time, children are escorted by CW Staff to A102. Following worship, parents of children ages 4 through Kindergarten must pick up their children from room A102. Children in grades 1-3 will be taken to their Sunday School classroom. Following 11:00 worship, parents must pick up their children from A102 which is the lower level of Building A.

HEARING ASSISTANCE DEVICES are available in the foyer.

WHEELCHAIR SEATING is readily available in the center aisle or an usher will be glad to remove a sanctuary chair for your convenience.

PRAYER FOCUS: Let's keep praying for an end to the war in Ukraine...and that the Lord would, in His mercy, redeem this somehow for His glory. Pray for the innocent Russians too, who will suffer greatly under the economic sanctions.

Service for Healing and Wholeness

"Come to Me, you weary, and I'll give us rest."
"Pray for and anoint for healing those who are sick."
"Ask, seek and knock, and you will find."

If you've never been part of a healing service before, here's how it works: all those seeking healing fill out a card, stating the need specifically or generally, then come to the altar for prayer as there is room. Confidential needs are kept confidential.

The needs of those who don't mind the congregation knowing their need will be shared (generally) then prayed for and anointed.

We continue like that until all who want prayer have been prayed for, then we'll receive Holy Communion together as a response to God's perfect and healing grace. The entire service lasts, generally, no more than one hour.
