1) Todo Mundo Feliz (TMF - Everyone's Happy) is a ministry planted at the edge of a slum controlled by drug lords in Santo Andre, Sao Paulo, Brazil. TMF operates a full-day pre-school program and a half-day program for children age 6 to 14. Its objective is to introduce children to Jesus, help them have better nutrition, hygiene, educational assistance and a safe place. This ministry helps prevent children from being recruited by drug traffickers. ICCM funding help is needed more than ever, since, due to changes in local governance, the municipality has withdrawn its support.

2) Salvation Army Every child should experience joy on Christmas morning. The Salvation Army Angel Tree program helps provide Christmas for children in Jessamine County through the generosity of Christian people. Thanks for being the hands and feet of Jesus to others in our community. The gifts for Salvation Army need to be placed under the tree, unwrapped by December 3.


