PRAYER FOCUS: As we pray for the many needs around us and around our world, let us faithfully give God thanks for His many, many blessings.


WORLD MISSION FOCUS—ARGENTINA: Pray for Andrea Tinsley working at The Harbor, an international church and university student housing ministry.






