- 1) Tomorrow is the first day for the return of some congregational singing to our corporate worship. Please, if you choose to sing, wear a mask while doing so. If you'd prefer to simply listen, of course that's fine as well.
- 2) Change to Baptism: Two candidates, Chloe Shafer and Jonah Evans will be baptized tomorrow, but not at the normal location or time. The baptism will instead be at the Shafer home, 1627 Brumfield Lane, Nicholasville at 2:00 p.m. All are welcome!
- 3) On September 6, we re-start our second worship service at 11:00 a.m. Both the 8:30a and 11:00a services will be 55 +/- minutes long, leaving time for the Layman's Class to use the Sanctuary in between services. Both will be live-streamed to Room B200-201 for those who would choose that option. The 8:30 a.m. service will also still be live-streamed online via the WFMC YouTube Channel for worship at home – link above.
- 4) Sunday September 6 is also Communion Sunday, so communion elements will be available in the foyer throughout the week next week for you to pick up, if you like.
