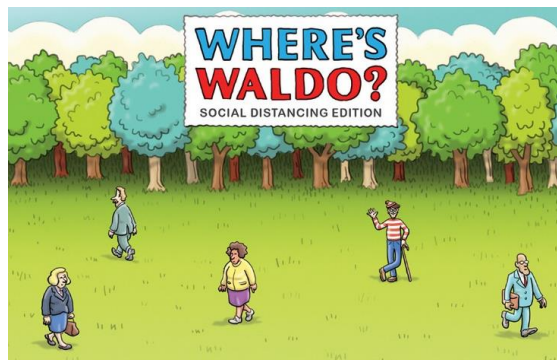
Children's Sunday School Classes will be beginning again on August 23rd. Stay tuned for details.
