“Thy Word is lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path.” This verse hung on the wall of my Sunday School classroom when I was a kid. Michael W. Smith and Amy Grant co-wrote a song with the same title. The story goes, Smith had written the music for a chorus, but didn’t know where to go with the verse. He shared this with Grant at a working retreat in Colorado, in the Rocky Mountains. That evening, Grant, became lost in the dark of the retreat grounds. Upon seeing a dim light in the distance she followed that light safety to her cabin. That night, she wrote the rest of the song.

Consider your journey with Jesus. When has God’s Word, the Scriptures, spoken so clearly to you, to your situation, to a deep hurt, or a surprising joy? This past week, I was reminded of our need as followers of Jesus, to dig down deep into His Word. Making His word our foundation, the rock on which we build our lives.




His Word will light your path. It will strength your soul. It will clarify your mind. His Word is alive and active (Heb 4:12).
