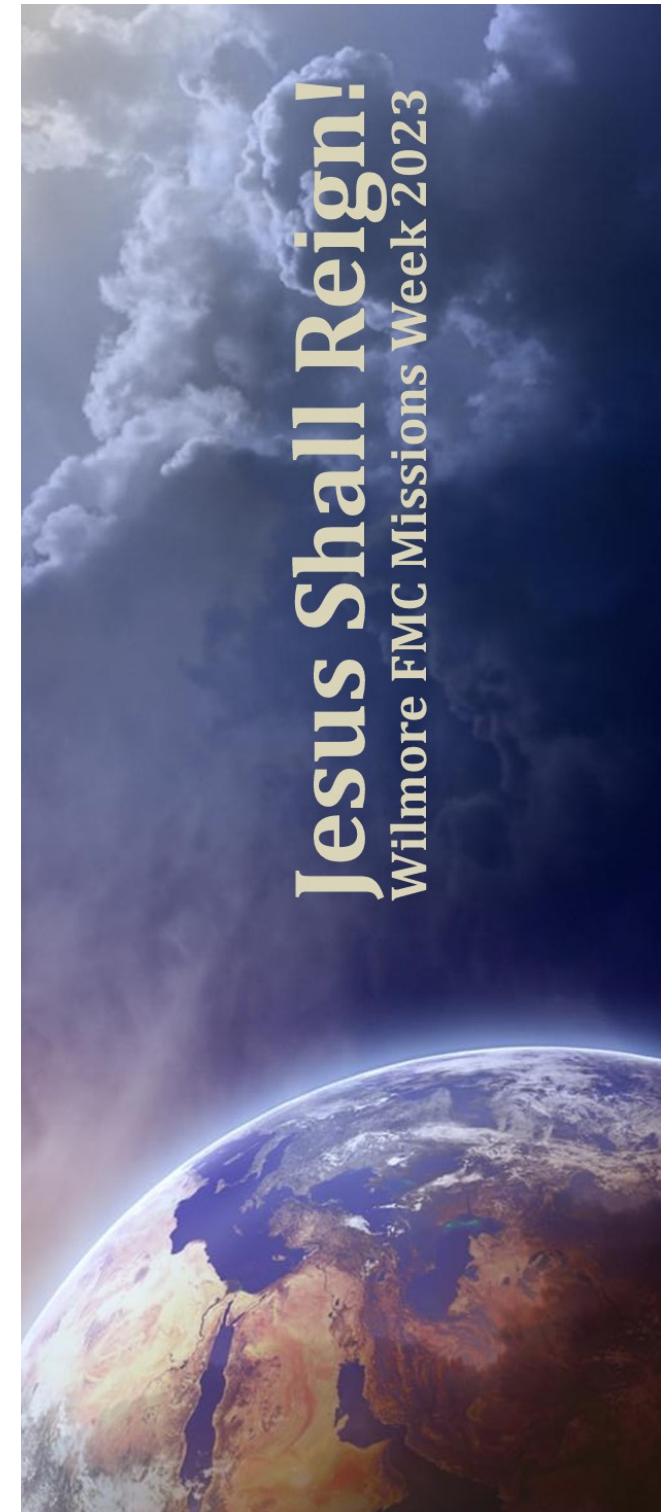

Dan and Hope have served in four major regions of Brazil over the past three decades. In 2020 they moved to the state of São Paulo to help restructure the Free Methodist seminary. Dan and Hope teach there, and Dan acts as academic coordinator. They are both involved in their local church and are mentoring church planters in northwest Brazil. Hope leads several Bible studies and is also part of a team adapting the Roots curriculum for FM Sunday schools in Latin America.

Rev. Dr. Angeline Savala is an ordained elder in the Free Methodist Church, pastor of the Shanjetso FMC, Chairperson of the Kenya Free Methodist Bible School, and a Lecturer in Religion at Masinde Muliro University of Science and Technology. Mr. Hicks is a community development worker and Director of the FADHILI Community Development Program. In 2018 they spent one year in Wilmore on a continuing education scholarship with Asbury Theological Seminary making Wilmore FMC their church home.

Financial Support

The home and world mission outreach ministries of the Wilmore Free Methodist Church are funded through designated offerings. To help support these mission programs, the church has implemented a dollar for dollar matching funds program. For each dollar received in designated offerings, the church contributes an additional dollar from the general budget up to the amount budgeted for missions for the year.
